

## AP ENROLLMENT POLICY

AP placement is based on a review of overall academic performance and testing. All students enrolled in an AP course are required to sit for the exam. Students can register for AP exams not offered at DAIS.

# **GRADING POLICY**

Academic grades are determined using a standards-based grading system which reports how well the student mastered the knowledge and skills from the adopted standards. Grades are based on academic factors only; non-academic factors such as attendance, behavior, effort, and responsibility are not factored into grades. **GPA is not weighted**. Only courses completed (excluding Applied Studies) at DAIS are calculated into an overall **GPA**. **GPA** is based on a 4.0 scale. Individual rank is not reported.

# **REPORTING POLICY**

Students at Dalian American International School are expected to exemplify the core values of integrity, respect and responsibility. When student behavior is not aligned with the school mission and core values, we believe that students should be held accountable for their actions and take responsibility for their mistakes; we also believe students should have the opportunity to grow and develop from these mistakes. Therefore, as an institution we do not report single discipline infractions to colleges and universities. When a student routinely violates the DAIS Code of Conduct, students are placed on behavior contracts to coach and monitor student behavior and character. Violation of behavior contracts will be shared with colleges and universities.
