

Type of activity




Fundraising: an event whose primary purpose is to raise money for a community partner




Mother's English

Mothers English is a China focused English learning support program of DMECC, currently led by Myungha Kim, a DAIS sophomore. Founded in 2016 with the goal to provide adequate English language support to primary age, Mothers English helps Chinese village students residing in Dalian. Mothers English strives to teach these children English through a friendly, engaging, and collaborative method. Currently, there are around 50 youth volunteers and around 100 Chinese students that are receiving support from Mothers English.

Diving Against Debris (DAD)

This is a global initiative under the umbrella of Project Aware. A local diving-instruction centre and friend of the school collaborates with the local government to coordinate dives in the local area to take PADI certified divers on direct 'fins in' action for the ocean, collecting critical survey data from any or every dive that can be used by marine researchers and policymakers for conservation efforts.









Sunday English lessons

September 2021 – June 2022

Every Sunday afternoon, youth volunteers teach the Chinese students English via Tencent Meeting, with each class 30 minutes long. Usually, every class consists of 5 village children that are either a part of the junior team (grade 2-4) or the senior team (grade 4-6).











Haunted House

The NHS students ran Haunted House as a part of Halloween's series of activities to raise money to run this organisation. It's also for culture promotion as we are an international school.


